CELEBRATING ADEN MOHAMED - 2025 recipient of the Eagle Award for Love

The Foundational Awards are presented annually to recognize employees who demonstrate respect, courage, humility, love, honesty, truth and wisdom in their daily work.

With the highest number of nominations from his teammates, Aden Mohamed is being recognized for the steady care, kindness and leadership he brings to the workplace every day. Those who nominated him describe him as a steady presence on the job — someone who notices when a teammate is struggling, steps in without being asked and follows up afterward to make sure that person is doing better. That consistency is part of what made his nomination stand out.

Originally from Africa, Aden has lived in Italy, Europe and the United States before making Canada home more than 30 years ago. He speaks seven languages and is known for consistently promoting kindness, togetherness and love on the job. Co-workers say that broad life experience shows in the way he connects with people from different backgrounds and helps others feel seen, respected and included. Whether during a shift or after hours, he checks in on colleagues with genuine concern and looks for ways to make their day better.

As a non-working foreman, Aden leads many workers, but teammates say his influence goes beyond the job itself. They describe him as someone who regularly reminds others to care for one another and who helps create a sense of unity and hope in a demanding work environment.

Stories like that are a large part of why Aden received such strong support from his peers.
